

Mathematics:

Children will be focusing on developing their fluency skills in the 2's, 5's and 10 times tables along with developing a secure understanding of fractions and 3D shapes in Year 2 and addition and subtraction in Year 1.

Music:

As musicians, children will use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

History:

In History, children will learn about creating timelines of both their own life and the lives of others. There will be a focus on chronology.

PSHE & Learning to Learn:

This term we will have a big focus on well-being with lots of opportunities to explore feelings and emotions. We will be looking at 'Financial Capability' and discuss how we can spend money in different ways and look at saving money. We will also explore 'wants' and 'needs' and the difference between them.



Science:

As scientists, we will be exploring the weather and how this changes in different parts of the world. We will make the different parts of a weather station. We will also be focussing on the Seasons and look at Seasonal Change.

Physical Education:

This term, we will be learning dances based on the different genres from the film 'Trolls'. We will focus on moving in time to the music. We will also be taking part in team games.

Religious Education:

Children will be using religious stories to explore different religions with a focus this term on Judaism. The children will recognise similarities and differences in the key features of religions with an added focus on Respect as one of our 7R's.

Art & DT:

As artists, we will be taking inspiration from Picasso's Le Pingouin for penguin form.

Children will use pastels and charcoal to develop their control to be able to smudge and blend. They will also work on drawing lines of different sizes and thickness.

We will also be continuing to explore colour mixing and look at hot and cold colours.

Computing:

This term we will continue our focus on e-safety and ensure that children know how to use technology safely as well as learning basic coding and algorythms.

Geography:

As geographers, we will compare the weather in a range of hot and cold countries. We will locate the continents and seas. We will ask questions around population and currency and look at different languages spoken across the world.

Writing:

As writers, we will be using the Jane Considine units to develop vocabulary. We will be focusing on expanded noun phrases and will look at the text 'the bear and the piano' to develop our narrative writing. We will also be looking at seasons poetry.
