# To understand how the tests will be administered

- ▶ Tests will be administered to all children under test conditions.
- ▶ Children will all be given verbal instructions for how to complete the test and will always be with a familiar adult.
- ▶ Tests will be administered across the week.
- ▶ Children will be made to feel at ease with the tests and whilst we will be following guidelines for administration, we will be ensuring children are as relaxed as possible whilst completing the tests.
