What a wonderful start to the school year! Not only is the sun shining, we have so many smiling children arriving at school, ready to focus on their learning and spend time with their friends.

I cannot start the new year without sharing the end of the year House Point Winners – Jonnie Peacock MBE (pink) were the winners with a total of 5852 House Points! Well done to all the House Teams who all managed to collect over 5 thousand points each. The winners cup is in the front entrance, currently with pink ribbons on it to represent the summer 2023 winners. Each half term the House Team in the lead has extra play together and the ribbons are changed on the cup.

So now, we begin again. Our House Team Key Influencers are changing from the sports theme with Jonnie Peacock MBE, Simone Biles, Marcus Rashford MBE and Tom Daley to Key Influencers with SEND.

Our pupils who left Year 6 in the summer spent time researching these and the new Key Influencers will be announced soon. House Points are awarded to all pupils for demonstrating our 7Rs of: Responsible, Resourceful, Respectful, Reflective, Resilient, Risk Taking and Relationships. We announce the cumulative totals in Celebration Assembly on a Friday. In this assembly, children may also receive 7R certificates awarded by their teachers for demonstrating the 7Rs in their learning.
