Have a clear understanding of what the phonics test will look like

The test will be administered during the week beginning 9th June 2025. During this week children will access the test on a 1:1 basis.

The test is purely testing their phonics knowledge.


The test is made up of 40 words, 20 of which are real and 20 words known as pseudo words (made up words) which the children will be asked to read.

Test will be administered by a familiar adult

Quiet space with no distractions

Understand how the children will be prepared for the test

Children will not experience anything other than Quality first phonics teaching leading up to the test. It will be kept very low key and all children will have been given the best opportunities to be ready for the test.

Children will be taught strategies to support them to access the test during their phonics lessons.

Children will be encouraged to use sound buttons when completing the test as this is part of their normal approach to sounding out unknown words.

Understand how you can support your child at home



Make reading fun



Have your child help you read out everyday words around them, like the shopping list.




Encourage and support them to recognise when more than one letter make a sound E.G: turn
